How to Use Your Carts

All materials must fit within the carts completely with lids closed; no extra materials outside the carts will be collected (except Tag A Bags; see p.3).*

YARD AND GARDEN WASTE: **Green Lid**

BI-WEEKLY curbside collection of yard and garden waste, March to November.

Residents are encouraged to explore alternative methods to reduce green waste like grasscycling and composting.

Put all yard waste loosely into cart. **NO** plastic bags or containers.

Do not pack materials into the cart: it will not empty when dumped.

Yard or garden waste is not permitted in the garbage cart.

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Weeds
- Plant trimmings
- Prunings and branches up to 5cm (2in) in diameter AND less than 1m (3ft) long
- Yard waste must fit in cart with lid closed

- No plastic bags
- No dirt, sod or rocks
- No kitchen waste
- No food waste or fruit droppings
- No diapers
- No used tissue or paper towels
- No regular garbage
- No tree stumps
- No animal feces or kitty litter
- No construction or renovation materials
- No agricultural or commercial waste

NO yard waste collection December, January or February.

How you place vour carts at the curb is very important. Unless vou have been contacted with special instructions, please place your carts at the curb as follows: Park it – Place your carts on the street, with the wheels against the curb, if there is one, or just off the roadway on the shoulder**.

Point it – The arrow on the cart lid must point to the centre of the road

Space it – Leave at least 1m (3ft) of clearance between each cart and any obstacles such as parked cars, poles, mailboxes, etc., for truck access. Carts improperly spaced will not be emptied.

Prepare your carts. All material must fit within the cart and the lid must be closed.
