## Pins and Badges

You will wear these pins, patches, emblems and badges on the upper front of the badge scarf in the following order:

Unit Title Tape - the name of the unit Brownie Enrolment Pin

Membership Pin - shows the number of years in Guiding

Circle Emblem - the Brownie unit is organized into smaller groups, called "circles". This shows which you are a member of.

Spark Fun and Friendship Pin - for girls who were in Sparks

Circle Leader and Circle Second

Patches - each circle has a leader and a second (who is a helper)

Interest Badges

Note regarding badges:

Any "interest" badges that the girls earn (these are the hexagonal ones shown in the Brownie program book) can be placed on the badge scarf as shown. Official Girl Guide "challenge" crests can also be placed anywhere on the scarf, but with the number of interest badges available you may want to put the challenge crests onto a camp blanket, poncho or hat. Otherwise you may run out of room for the interest badges.

When you receive other crests, such as fun birthday crests, activity crests, or non-Guiding crests, they are not to be sewn onto the badge scarf. Instead, sew them onto a camp blanket, poncho or hat. This is a great way to display all of the crests in your "collection".

You can secure your badge scarf with a special pin or just with a safety pin.
